General Instruction

CCA: Children can participate in any 2 Literary competition and overall in any 3 CCA competitions.

ECA: Children can participate in any 3 group games and in any 2 individual games for ECA competitions.

Children can participate in the events as per the list submitted and change of events is not permitted during the middle of the year. Change of participation can be made on Medical Grounds / On duty cases with approval from the competent authority.

Kindly instruct the students, for all individual competitions (Art & Craft, Poster Making etc.)

Flower Arrangement (Individual Competition) (Gr. II,III,IV,V,VI)	03.02.2027	Arrangement of flowers on a Base. ➤ All houses will have one participant from each class ➤ The Area of the table will be 75.6cm X 92cm (LxB) ➤ Height of the arrangement should not exceed 60 cm. ➤ Each student will be given 90 minutes to complete the work. ➤ Using of precut leaves or flowers will lead to disqualification. ➤ Usage of base is restricted to maximum of two bricks only. ➤ Students should use plastic brick holder only. ➤ The cost of the flowers used for the arrangement must not exceed Rs.1000/- Note: A common circular regarding the rules will be send to selected students one week before the competition date.
